Rooms Reps Wanted!

Are you looking for a way to support your child's teacher? Consider volunteering to be a PTSA Room Rep! Room Reps provide an additional communication link between the classroom teacher and Allen Creek families. You don't need to be physically in the classroom either as emails can be sent out when your schedule allows during the day.

Communications may include:

- Encouraging families to support PTSA through annual membership
- Inviting families to sign up for school directory information online
- Sending reminder emails for class and some school activities
- Reminding families to sign up for volunteer opportunities
- Helping with field trip and class activity sign-up sheets (done through Sign Up Genius)
- Requesting donations of class materials (ex. more Purell or snack backups)
